

THE LANGUAGE OF THE FISH: A STRUCTURAL ANALYSIS OF PISCAN EXPRESSION

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Abstract: This article explores the often-overlooked role of individual differences in shaping linguistic expression, with a particular focus on personality archetypes and zodiac-based tendencies. While traditional linguistic analysis emphasizes universal structures of language, it frequently neglects how subjective perception influences communication. This study aims to examine the linguistic features associated with individuals born under the Pisces zodiac sign and to analyze how they construct meaning, express emotions, and interpret discourse across different contexts. The research enters the pseudo-scientific domain of astrology and introduces the concept of astro-linguistics as a framework for understanding symbolic and intuitive modes of communication. The findings suggest that Piscean expression is characterized by indirectness, metaphorical richness, emotional layering, and fluid discourse structures, which distinguish it from more linear and explicit communicative styles. It is shaped by personality, psychological tendencies, and, as this article explores, even symbolic systems like astrology. Although astrology is not considered a scientific discipline, it provides a rich framework of archetypes that describe human behavior and perception. Among these archetypes, Pisces is often associated with sensitivity, imagination, emotional depth, and fluid thinking. These qualities raise an interesting question: Can such traits influence the way language is structured and used?

This article attempts to answer that question by introducing the concept of astro-linguistics, a perspective that connects language with symbolic identity. The focus is not to prove astrology as a science, but to use it as a lens to explore how certain personality patterns may shape communication. RESULTS

Emotional Depth and Layering: A single sentence can carry multiple emotional meanings at once. There is often a mixture of vulnerability, reflection, and subtle intensity. This creates a deeper but sometimes less accessible form of communication [3].

Indirectness and Suggestion: Rather than stating ideas clearly, Piscean expression often suggests meaning. The listener or reader is expected to interpret and feel the message, not just understand it logically. This can create beauty in communication, but also misunderstanding [1].

Sensitivity to Context: Meaning in Piscean language depends heavily on context. Tone, situation, and emotional background are essential. Without them, the message may seem unclear or incomplete.

Use of Silence and Incompleteness: An interesting feature is the presence of pauses, unfinished sentences, or implied meanings. Sometimes what is not said carries more weight than what is explicitly expressed.

DISCUSSION

The findings challenge the traditional idea that effective communication must always be clear, direct, and structured. While such qualities are important in many contexts, they do not represent the full range of human expression. Piscean language shows that communication can also be intuitive, emotional, and symbolic. It does not always aim to inform it aims to evoke. It does not only deliver meaning, it invites interpretation.

This creates both strengths and limitations. On one hand, Piscean expression allows for depth, creativity, and emotional connection. It can capture feelings that cannot easily be explained in logical terms. On the other hand, it may lead to ambiguity and misunderstanding, especially in academic or formal environments where clarity is expected.

The concept of astro-linguistics, although not scientifically validated, serves as a useful conceptual tool. It encourages us to think about language not just as a system, but as a reflection of identity and perception. In this sense, the “language of the fish” is not just about Pisces—it represents a broader category of human communication that values feeling over form, and intuition over structure.

CONCLUSION
